

VICTORIABANK will support the participants at this year's Republican Olympics in Mathematics as it previously did.

VICTORIABANK will sponsor the second year consequently the participating of the students from Grades VII-VIII at the Republican Olympics in Mathematics to be held in the period between February 29 and March 3, giving them the opportunity to participate at the most important national mathematics competition held in between students.

The idea to continue the partial sponsoring of the Republican Olympics in Mathematics by VICTORIABANK came with the start of the partnership between the bank and the Ministry of Youth and Education of the Republic Moldova. At this year's edition VICTORIABANK will sponsor the accommodation and food for the pupils and will provide money awards to winners, the big award being of 1000 lei, two awards of 800 lei, 3 awards of 600 Lei and 4 awards of 400 lei. In addition, VICTORIABANK will ensure with files, notebooks and pens all participants in the competition. And besides that VICTORIABANK prepared some events for higher grades, which are also participating in this Olympics.

According to VICTORIABANK speaker, Inga Țugui, the support offered by the bank in order to carry out the Republican Olympics in Mathematics is part of an action plan designed to contribute to the development of a new generation of young people. Meanwhile, the bank supports for the second year the participation of students at the Olympics from Grades VII-VIII, because this constitutes a real opportunity to affirm, to gain experience and verify the mathematical knowledge, in particular, within a competition at a national level as the Republican Olympics in Mathematics, also mentioned Inga Țugui.

It is to note that VICTORIABANK participates in a second consecutive edition of the Republican Olympics in Mathematics and, just like o in 2007, will sponsor the full participation in the Olympics of students of Grades VII-VIII.

The Sponsorship of the Republican Olympics in Mathematics comes two months after the termination of a pilot project in six high schools from Kishinev, the purpose of which was to stimulate students to gain high results, and the best to be awarded. Previously, in the summer and autumn of 2007 VICTORIABANK sponsored the Campaign "Put your mind to work", held in 12 higher education institutions from the country, a project under which VICTORIABANK offered five computers to the best students. Through these actions VICTORIABANK wants to stimulate the pupils and the students to achieve high results in the studying process, to gain deeper knowledge and to discover and develop new abilities that will lead to the students' further personality development.
